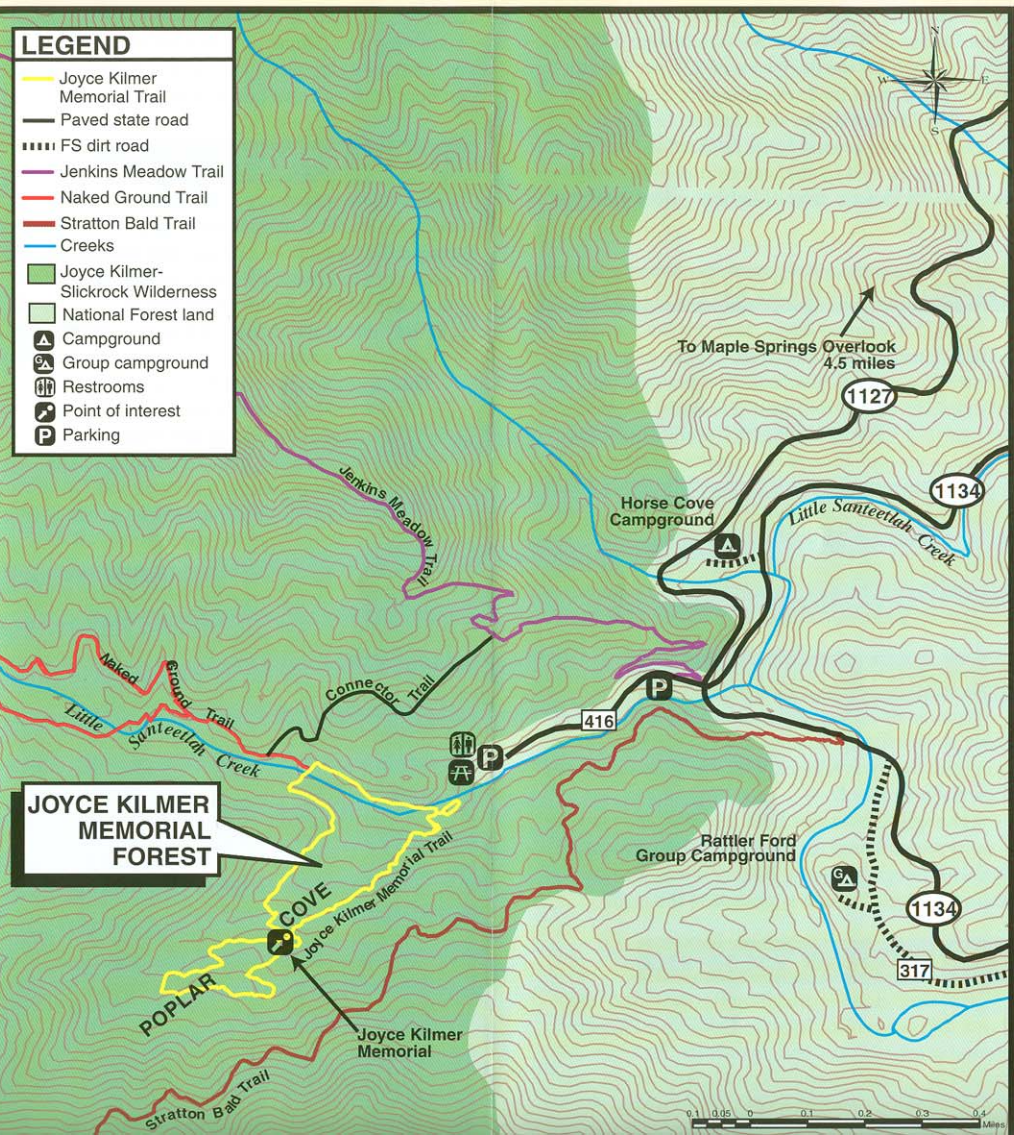

DIRECTIONS

FROM ASHEVILLE: Take I-40W to Exit 27. Exit right onto U.S. 19/74 toward Waynesville. Go about 47 miles and bear right on NC 28N. Go five miles and turn left on NC 143 to Robbinsville.

FROM ROBBINSVILLE: Take NC 143W. After about 12 miles, turn right on Joyce Kilmer Road (SR1134). Go two miles and turn left to forest.
